

Role and Commitments of International Centre for Birds of Prey to SAVE



The International Centre for Birds of Prey (ICBP) has had a longstanding and very prominent role for SAVE, and its Director Jemima Parry-Jones has had an even longer association with vultures and the Asian Vulture Crisis.

Role and commitments to SAVE:

- Providing technical and funding support, including regular training visits
- Initiating survey work on safe NSAIDs using on injured or captive vultures (and other raptors)
- Design of conservation breeding programme in India and Nepal
- Assisting veterinarians in assessing vulture health, welfare and husbandry
- Design of release enclosures and procedures for Nepal, and where applicable in India
- Co-chairing the TAC and assisting with advocacy and people politics
- Two-decade commitment to the project
